#### Member & Guest Code of Conduct

As always, safety should be first.

Regulation 3: Intoxication and controlled substances W. Maine VW Club promotes safety. Please refrain from doing drugs or drinking to excess while at any club events. We don't want to contribute to any impaired drivers. If we have any meet ups at a location that serves alcohol, we ask that you drink responsibly. Any unruly, intoxicated, chemically impaired person may be asked to leave. Anyone intoxicated, chemically impaired and / or unable to drive will either surrender their keys to a sober driver, or will take a cab. Use of illegal and / or controlled substances during a club meeting, event, or function may result in immediate loss of Club Membership.
